## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Appropriating \$20,000.00 for the Development of a Multiple Attorney Contract System)

WHEREAS,	in	August	of	1988	the	Domestic	Affairs	Committee	
	subi	mitted to	the	Budget	and	Finance	Committee	a request	
	for	funding	the	effort	to	develop	a "multiple	attorney	
	contract system"; and								

- WHEREAS, there is a need to make specific and concrete the "multiple attorney contract system" proposal so that it can be fully considered; and
- WHEREAS, fulfilling this need requires a special appropriation for the purpose of retaining a "Special Counsel on Counsel" under the supervision of the Domestic Affairs Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee on February 6, 1989 recommended unanimously that such a special appropriation be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Nation that:

- For fiscal year 1989 the sum of \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated to retain a Special Counsel on Counsel under the supervision of the Domestic Affairs Committee;
- 2. The duties of the Special Counsel on Counsel shall be to:
  - investigate and develop further the multiple attorney contract system proposal
  - present legislation, including proposed attorney contracts, required to implement the multiple attorney contract proposal;
- 3. The Domestic Affairs Committee and the Judiciary Committee are authorized to negotiate a "Special Counsel on Counsel" contract with an appropriate legal practitioner and present the contract for approval through the required constitutional process.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th. day of February , 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,399.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c), (2), & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
