

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Citizen Participation Certification)

RES. NO. 61-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is submitting an application  
2 for a grant to fund certain eligible Indian Community  
3 Development Block Grant Program activities and in  
4 connection with such application resolved and made  
5 certain assurances.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
7 Council that prior to the submission of its application,  
8 the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation has  
9 provided tribal citizens through their Council Repre-  
10 sentatives, especially those living in areas where  
11 activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate  
12 information concerning the amount of funds available for  
13 proposed community development and housing activities,  
14 the range of activities that may be assisted, and other  
15 important program requirements and solicited their views  
16 and participation.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traditional Tribal means of citizen  
18 involvement were followed through District Council  
19 meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
20 meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs,  
21 express preferences about proposed community development  
22 and housing activities, assist in the selection of  
23 district priorities, and otherwise participate in the  
24 development of the application.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no part of this paragraph shall be  
26 construed to restrict the responsibility and authority  
27 of the applicant for development of the application and  
28 the execution of its Community Development Block Grant  
29 Program. Accordingly, the citizen participation  
30 requirements of this paragraph do not include concur-  
31 rence by any person or group involved in citizen parti-  
32 cipation in making final determinations concerning the  
findings and contents of the application. The sole

responsibility and authority to make such final  
determinations rest exclusively with the Tohono O'odham  
Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
on the 21st day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a  
quorum was present with a vote of 1,383.0 for; -0- against; -0-  
not voting; and 257.0 (10) absent, pursuant to the powers vested  
in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)(d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of  
the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the  
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)  
on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
