

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Demographic Data)

RES. NO. 62-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona has submitted an  
2 application for a grant under the Community Development  
3 Block Grant Program for Indian Tribes; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation elects to submit demographic  
5 data that are unpublished and not generally available in  
6 order to meet the requirements of the application  
7 process.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
9 Council, in accordance with 24 CFR 571-300 (c) that:

- 10 1. Generally available, published data are substan-  
11 tially inaccurate or incomplete.  
12 2. The data provided have been collected systemati-  
13 cally.  
14 3. Data are, to the greatest extent feasible,  
15 independently verifiable.  
16 4. Data differentiates between reservation and BIA  
17 service area populations.

18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
19 on the 21st day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a  
20 quorum was present with a vote of 1,383.0 for; -0- against;  
21 -0- not voting; and 257.0 (10) absent, pursuant to the powers  
22 vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) (d)(2) & (f) of  
23 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,  
24 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and  
25 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
26 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
27 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


