

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Community Development Block Grant Application)

RES. NO. 63-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did solicit the participation
2 of the eleven political districts of the Tohono O'odham
3 Reservation for priority needs for their respective
4 districts; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did receive a proposal from
6 the following districts and entities of the Nation:

- 7 1. Gu Achi District - Upper Covered Wells Community,
Waste Disposal Facility;
- 8 2. Gu Achi District - Electrification of Sikol Himatke;
- 9 3. Sells District - Sewer System Upgrade;
- 10 4. Schuk Toak District - San Pedro Community Well
11 Construction; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council had determined it
13 is in the best interest of the Nation to apply for
14 Community Development Block Grant Program funds for the
15 purpose of the above-projects; and

16 WHEREAS, the specific Districts/Communities have passed
17 resolutions and adopted policies regarding
18 implementation of these projects.

19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
20 Council does recognize and accept those resolutions and
21 policies implemented by the Districts/Communities, as
22 regards the application for and completion of these
23 projects.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
25 that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, Vice Chairman to
26 consult with and negotiate for Community Development
27 Block Grant funding to execute any and all contracts and
28 legal documents and any amendments thereto which may be
29 necessary to implement the projects.

30 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
31 on the 21st day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a
32 quorum was present with a vote of 1,383.0 for; -0- against;
-0- not voting; and 257.0 (9) absent, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1 (c), (2), & (f) of Article VI
of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the

Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
