RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Sells Reservation Water Study)

RES. NO. 67-89

1 WHEREAS, Section 303 (b) (1) of Title III of P.L. 97-293, the  
2 Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982  
3 authorized and directed that a study be done to  
4 determine the availability and suitability of water  
5 resources within the Sells Papago Reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, the study is divided into three phases:

7 Phase I: Research and Field Implementation

8 Phase II: Test Drilling and Summary Reports

9 Phase III: Data Analyses and Summary Reports; and

10 WHEREAS, Phase I is 98% complete; and

11 WHEREAS, Phase II is 12% complete; and

12 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a substantial  
13 amount of drilling in conjunction with the inventory in  
14 Phase II; and

15 WHEREAS, the total inventory cost as listed in the program budget  
16 projections will be \$40,000,000.00; and

17 WHEREAS, funding up-to-date is \$3,840,000.00; and

18 WHEREAS, funding for drilling must be in place before drilling  
19 commences due to contracts that must be awarded with  
20 specific performance and payment security.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the current estimated cost to  
22 complete the study mandated by section 303 (b) (1) is  
23 \$40,000,000.00 and the Tohono O'Odham Council hereby  
24 requests that Congress make future appropriations as  
25 provided in the attached schedule dated February 23,  
26 1989.

28 The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham  
29 Council on the 27th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which  
30 a quorum was present with a vote of 344.0 for; 969.0 against;  
31 327.0 not voting; and 03 absent, failed to pass because it did  
32 not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2  
of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.




