

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(JTPA/SDA Title II-B Summer Youth Employment & Training
Program for Calendar Year 1989)

RES. NO. 72-89

1 WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) was enacted into
2 law in 1982 replacing the Comprehensive Employment and
3 Training Act (CETA); and

4 WHEREAS, funding is made available through the United States De-
5 partment of Labor to states and tribal governments to
6 establish employment and training programs for youths
7 and adults for the purposes of improving employment
8 prospects; and

9 WHEREAS, nineteen (19) Indian Reservations including the Tohono
10 O'odham Nation, in the State of Arizona have been
11 designated as a Tribal Service Delivery Area (TSDA) and
12 are entitled to receive State JTPA funds; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation JTPA may apply for State JTPA
14 funds pursuant to the Inter-Governmental Agreement with
15 the State of Arizona; and

16 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation since Calendar Year (CY) 1984
17 has operated JTPA Title II-B Summer Youth Employment and
18 Training Program Contracts with the State of Arizona.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's
20 Legislative Council does hereby approve the JTPA Title
21 II-B Contracts in the amount of \$151,598.00.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
25 being conducted and no executed contract has been
26 awarded by the United States Department of Labor.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
29 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
30 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
31 contracts, provided however, that any amendments
32 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contracts

shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 28th day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against;
-0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in
the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
