## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Request for Housing Improvement Program)

RES. NO. 73-89

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has a membership of 16,500; 1 and 2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is participating in the Bureau 3 of Indian Affairs Home Improvement Program (HIP); and 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has listed elderly and 5 handicapped people high priority for assistance; and 6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully constructed 7 over 200 Category "D" homes up to January, 1989; and 8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has an unmet need of 2,300 9 additional new units or rehabilitation of units; and 10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has up to 35% to 45% of its 11 units in need of adequate water and sanitary facilities. 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative 13 Council that the Bureau of Indian Affairs be required to 14 adequately fund at a level to meet the needs of the 15 Tohono O'odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 28th day of  $\frac{\text{February}}{\text{a}}$ ,  $\frac{1989}{\text{of}}$  at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  $\frac{1}{577.0}$  for;  $\frac{-0}{-0}$  against; 63.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  $\frac{1}{(c)}$ ,  $\frac{(c)}{(2)}$ ,  $\frac{(c)}{(2)}$ ,  $\frac{(c)}{(2)}$  of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
