

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Affirmation of Sand Papagos - Federal Legislation)

RES. NO. 77-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, formerly known as the Papago
2 Tribe, did by Council Resolution No. 30-81 and 16-84
3 recognize the Sand Papagos/Hia-Ced O'odham as the
4 original inhabitants of the western portion of
5 Papaguera, and agreed to support and assist the Hia-Ced
6 O'odham in their struggle to acquire a homeland; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1984 a bill, H.R. 4745 was submitted to Congress on
8 behalf of the Hia-Ced O'odham by the Tohono O'odham
9 Nation in order to set aside federal land for their
10 benefit; and

11 WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'odham have proposed federal legislation
12 which would transfer and reserve all vacant Bureau of
13 Land Management lands in the Ajo area for the use and
14 occupancy of Sand Papagos and as an addition to the
15 Tohono O'odham Nation, to become the twelfth district of
16 the Nation; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation by this resolution serves
18 notice to Congress that the Sand Papagos/Hia-Ced O'odham
19 are still in dire need of a homeland and that it will
20 continue its efforts to accommodate the people.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
22 Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby reaffirms
23 its support and continued assistance to the Sand
24 Papagos/Hia-Ced O'odham.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the officers, agents and represent-
26 atives of the Tohono O'odham Nation are hereby
27 authorized and directed in a timely and efficient manner
28 to initiate and process through Congress the legislation
29 proposed by this resolution.

30 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
31 on the 28th day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a
32 quorum was present with a vote of 1,059.0 for; -0- against;
581.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
in the Council by Section 1 (c) (2) & (i)(3) of Article VI of
the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the

1 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
2 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
3 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
