## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (H.R. 2506, Border Crossing Bill)

WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council did by Resolution $\underline{127-87}$ request
	Congress to enact a law which would recognize the right
	of any person of Tohono O'odham descent who is not a
	citizen of the United States to pass and repass freely
	the borders of the United States and live and work in
	the United STates; and

- WHEREAS, in response to such request, Congressman Morris K. Udall did introduce H.R. 2506 and the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs did conduct hearings thereon; and
- WHEREAS, Ross O. Swimmer, Assistant Secretary of the Interior, did by letter dated June 21, 1988, provide the committee with the Administration's response to H.R. 2506 in the nature of a substitute bill; and
- WHEREAS, the Legislative Council had serious objections to provisions in the substitute bill which could not be properly addressed within the time limitation set for Congressional mark-up and hearings; and
- WHEREAS, in view of the Administration's refusal to support H.R.

  2506 in its current form the Legislative Council did
  withdraw H.R. 2506 from further consideration during the
  last session of Congress; and
- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council believes that the right of free passage for the Tohono O'odham living in United States and Mexico is essential for their religious observances and enjoyment of family, social and cultural relations, and that it is necessary and incumbent on Congress to clarify this right by legislation.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
  Council that it does hereby request Senator Dennis
  DeConcini and John McCain and Congressman Morris K.
  Udall and Jim Kolbe to sponsor and support a bill with
  the same provisions contained in H.R. 2506 that was

introduced in the first session by the 100th Congress, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate officers, agents and attorneys of the Tohono O'odham Nation are hereby authorized and directed to do everything necessary to implement the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 28th day of February , 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c) (2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
