

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Special Meeting set for March 3, 1989 to
address Health Concerns)

RES. NO. 81-89

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on February 28, 1989 were
2 presented with a report on the Tohono O'Odham Nation's
3 P.L. 93-638 Health Contracts by the District Chairmen of
4 the Eleven (11) Districts which addresses their concerns
5 under the Health Department; and

6 WHEREAS, the most important issue is the notice received on
7 February 27, 1989 advising the Districts of the
8 following, "Transportation and the CHR Program:
9 Beginning Wednesday, March 1, the CHR will no longer be
10 able to take most of you to clinic in Sells, San Xavier,
11 or Santa Rosa"; and

12 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council agreed that the issue concerning
13 the patients transportation should be addressed by the
14 following:

- 15 - Edwin Hansen, Executive Director, Tohono O'Odham
16 Nation Health Department
- 17 - Andrew Lorentine, Assistant Director, TOHCD
- 18 - Sharmaine Garcia, Chairperson, TOHCD Board of
Directors
- 19 - All members, TOHCD Board of Directors
- 20 - Julie Carrillo, Chairperson, Tohono O'Odham Health and
21 Human Services Legislative Committee
- 22 - All members, Tohono O'Odham Health and Human Services
Legislative Committee

23 with the hope of arriving at some solution; and

24 WHEREAS, some of the above mentioned personnel are under the
25 supervision of the Chairman of the Nation and the
26 Legislative Council feels that his presence is necessary
27 for the meeting set for Friday, March 3, 1989 at 9:00
28 a.m.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that a
30 meeting has been set for Friday, March 3, 1989 to
31 address the District Chairmen's concerns as outlined in
32 the P.L. 93-638 Report and the resolution of the

1 District Chairmen of the Tohono O'Odham Nation passed by
2 the District Chairmen.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all the individuals mentioned in the
4 resolution of the District Chairmen of the Tohono
5 O'Odham Nation and the P.L. 93-638 Report be present for
6 this meeting.

7 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any action on all Health Budgets will
8 be postponed until this issue is resolved.

9 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
10 on the 28th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a
11 quorum was present with a vote of 1,395.0 for; -0- against;
12 245.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
13 in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the
14 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
15 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
16 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
17 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
18 Stat. 984).


