(CHR Continuation of Transporting Patients)

RES. NO. 82-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did discuss the
2 Memorandum which reduces transportation for patients;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council after
5 discussion on the matter felt that the abrupt
6 announcement have not given more time for the public to
7 become aware of this reduction in transportation.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the CHR continue to provide
9 transportation for the patients until this matter is
10 resolved.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
12 on the 28th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a
13 quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0-
14 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
15 Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
16 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
17 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
19 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
20 984).
