

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Archaeological mitigation recommendations for
Schuk Toak Farm Development)

RES. NO. 86-89

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council convened in a
2 meeting on March 2, 1989 and approved the guidelines for
3 archaeological mitigation for the Schuk Toak New
4 Development; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Nation's Archaeological
6 Protection Ordinance (No. 06-84) human remains will not
7 be available for study; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Schuk Toak District Resolution No. 2-7-89 is attached
9 hereto and made a part thereof; and
- 10 WHEREAS, artifacts will not be photographed; and
- 11 WHEREAS, drawings of artifacts, excluding burials, will be
12 allowed; and
- 13 WHEREAS, artifacts that are not associated with burials that will
14 be allowed to be studied are included on the list,
15 Artifacts To Be Studied, attached hereto and made a part
16 hereof; and
- 17 WHEREAS, these artifacts will be studied within Schuk Toak
18 District of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, unless otherwise
19 directed by the Schuk Toak District Council; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council realizes that a
21 very small percentage of the artifacts will need to be
22 studied by specialized personnel and equipment that is
23 not available within the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and
- 24 WHEREAS, a list of and quantities of Artifacts To Be Studied Off
25 Reservation is attached hereto and made a part hereof;
26 and
- 27 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation wishes that the curation of
28 all artifacts recovered from the Southern Arizona Water
29 Rights Settlement Act project within the Schuk Toak
30 District, be within the Schuk Toak District of the
31 Tohono O'Odham Nation, unless otherwise directed by the
32 Schuk Toak District Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that it hereby approves the guidelines set forth
in this resolution for archaeological mitigation for the
Schuk Toak New Development.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 2nd day of March, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,496.5 for; -0- against; 143.5 not
voting; and 07 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1 (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
