

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Dismissing Motion to Continue Filed in Court of Removal)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 89-89

1 WHEREAS, William Logan Farrison and Teresa Dawn Farrison,
2 attorneys for Enos Francisco, Jr. and Angelo J. Joaquin,
3 Sr, respectively the Chairman and the Vice Chairman of
4 the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Accused in the removal
5 proceedings brought before the Legislative Council
6 sitting as a Court of Removal, having filed their Notice
7 of Appearance on behalf of the Accused, and having filed
8 a Motion to Continue All Proceedings; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, sitting as a Court of Removal,
10 having considered the motion and supporting memorandum,
11 and having determined that it is in the best interest of
12 the Tohono O'odham Nation and of its people and the
13 Accused, that the hearing on the Accusations move ahead
14 as scheduled.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Motion to Continue All
16 Proceedings dated March 2, 1989, filed by the Accused
17 Enos Francisco, Jr. and Angelo J. Joaquin with this
18 Council, sitting as a Court of Removal, is hereby
19 denied, and it is hereby ordered that a consolidated
20 trial on the Accusations will be held on Monday, March
21 13, 1989, at 10:00 a.m., as provided in Legislative
22 Order No. 60-89.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Legislative Order be
24 served forthwith upon counsel for the Accused.

25 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
26 Council on the 3rd day of March, 1989 at a meeting at which a
27 quorum was present with a vote of 1,545.0 for; -0- against;
28 95.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
29 in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI and Section 1 of
30 Article XIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
31 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and
32 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
