

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Reaffirming Resolution No. 82-89 "CHR Continuation
of Transporting Patients")

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did set March 3,
2 1989 aside to further discuss the issue of transporting
3 patients to clinics and hospitals; and


4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has heard from
5 the various entities involved; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has determined to
7 focus on the issue of transportation.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
9 Council that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 82-89
10 "CHR Continuation of Transporting Patients."

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
13 on the 3rd day of March, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
14 was present with a vote of 726.0 for; 681.0 against; 233.0 not
15 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
16 Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
17 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
18 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
20 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
21 984).


