

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Judicial Services Budget Amendment and Contract Extension)

RES. NO. 94-89

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did authorize the extension of
2 the Judicial Services Contract for fiscal year 1988 to
3 facilitate the expenditure of funds expected to be saved
4 by September 30, 1988; and

5 WHEREAS, this authorizing resolution numbered 239-88 did provide
6 for the addition of FY '89 Judicial Services funds to
7 the extended contract upon notification of the
8 availability of such funds; and

9 WHEREAS, the Judiciary has received the advice of allotment for
10 FY '89 Judicial Services funds which include the base
11 amount of \$145,000.00 plus an additional amount of
12 \$68,000.00; and

13 WHEREAS, a proposed budget identifying how the FY '89 funds will
14 be spent has been prepared and reviewed by the Judiciary
15 Committee of the Legislative Council; and

16 WHEREAS, the addition of FY '89 Judicial Services funds will
17 enable the Judiciary to plan services and programs
18 through September 30, 1989; and

19 WHEREAS, the extended contract is due to expire March 31, 1989,
20 unless extended for additional months; and

21 WHEREAS, an extension of the FY '88 Judicial Services contract
22 has proven efficient and enabled the Judiciary to
23 provide continuity in services and operations.


24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
25 Legislative Council does hereby approve and authorize
26 the modification submitted to expend the FY '89 Judicial
27 Services appropriation and directs the Bureau of Indian
28 Affairs to approve such modification for expenditure
29 during FY '89 in accordance with the attached budget.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY '88 Judicial Services Contract
31 is hereby modified and extended through September 30,
32 1989.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
2 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
3 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
4 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
5 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
6 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
7 submitted for prior approval by this Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
9 on the 21st day of March, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
10 was present with a vote of 1,409.0 for; 120.5 against; 110.5
11 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
12 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
13 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
14 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
16 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
17 984).
